

MACS and Singapore Bus Requirements

Singapore Bus Requirements

To travel on the Singapore Scheduled Buses, all pupils must have MACS (Malaysian Automated Clearance System) and eIACS (enhanced-Immigration Automated Clearance System). This means that they can go through the automatic lane at both Singapore and Malaysian Immigration.

Singapore eIACS

This is the thumbprint on the back of your Dependant's Pass (DP)

Anyone over six years old can have their thumbprint on their DP.

Please contact either ICA or MOM (depending on your immigration status) to arrange for this.

This is generally straightforward but can become a problem if you are approaching the end of your visa term or changing status.

Malaysian MACS Pass

To apply you must have six empty pages on your passport and a supporting letter from the College.

All Malaysian Long Term Pass holders are eligible to apply for a MACS pass, this includes pupils holding Malaysian Student Passes, MM2H, Guardian Visa, Malaysian Employment Pass and Dependents Pass. Apply at Iskandar Regional Development Authority (IRDA). They will issue the MACS Pass immediately.
